4 (1) (B) (XVII) SUCH OTHER INFORMATION AS MAY BE THE PRESCRIBED

- h) "Public Authority" means any authority or body or institution of self-government established or constituted-
- a) by or under the constitution;
- b) by any other law made by Parliament;
- c) by any other law made by State Legislature;
- d) by notification issued or order made by the appropriate Government, and includes any
 - i) Body owned, controlled or substantially financed;
- ii) Non-Government organization substantially financed, directly or indirectly by funds provided by the appropriate Government;

By applying 2(h) (d), every affiliated college under the jurisdiction of ANU becomes pubic authority.

Hence, any information pertaining to the affiliated colleges can be had from the respective PIO's of the college and first appeals can also be made to respective first appellate authority.
